Residency programme in large animal surgery (horses, ECVS)

Training to become a specialist in large animal surgery

Brief content description:

Practical training in equine surgery. Short courses in anaesthesiology, diagnostic imaging, internal medicine, and pathology. Scientific activity during designated research time (25% of working time): conducting a first-author original study in the field of large animal surgery (publication in a peer-reviewed scientific journal) and writing a first-author case report.

Duration and Location:

The duration of the programme is 3 years.

Main locations: Equine hospital; rotations in various departments including anaesthesiology, diagnostic imaging, and pathology. Rotations can be completed internally, i.e., at the Vetsuisse Faculty Bern, or externally.

Program Objective (ECVS-Board-Exam):

Meeting the requirements for admission to the ECVS Board Exam.
