Specialisation Committee Vetsuisse Faculty Bern:

Residency Programme in Small Animal Internal Medicine (ECVIM-CA)

Brief content description:

The main objective of the programme is to train residents as specialists in small animal internal medicine. This is achieved through direct supervision of clinical cases under the guidance of a senior assistant, participation in internal and external continuing education events, and conducting a clinical research project.

Duration and Location:

The minimum duration of the training is 3 years. A full-time position in regular employment is typically required. Training periods at other European training centres may be recognised by the Credential Committee of the ECVIM-CA. At the end of the programme, the candidate must take an examination to obtain Diplomate status.
