



Specialisation Committee Vetsuisse Faculty Bern:

Residency Programme European Veterinary Parasitology College (EVPC)

Brief content description:

The aim of the programme is to further educate veterinarians as specialists in the field of veterinary parasitology according to the guidelines of the European Veterinary Parasitology College (EVPC). The training includes thorough immersion in diagnostic aspects of veterinary parasitology, complemented by the development of a portfolio of clinical cases and individual research activities.

Duration and Location:

The programme consists of a 4-year training phase in veterinary parasitology under the supervision of an EVPC Diplomate. At the end of the training, candidates undergo the examination for Diplomate of the European Veterinary Parasitology College, and if desired, the examination for the FVH in Basic and Laboratory Medicine with a specialisation in Parasitology.

The training includes a comprehensive introduction to all diagnostic laboratory activities, participation in routine diagnostics commensurate with the level of training, and assistance in student education. Additionally, time is allocated for individual research and participation in conferences and further education. The necessary external internships of the resident(s) are supported. Following successful evaluation by the EVPC Committee, the Diplomate EVPC exam can be taken in autumn at different European universities.

Programme Objective (Board-Exam):

Attainment of the title Diplomate of the European Veterinary Parasitology College.
