# **Residency Programme in Veterinary Neurology**

(Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Neurology, Dipl. ECVN, EBVS® European Specialist in Veterinary Neurology)

### **Brief content description:**

Practical and theoretical training in veterinary neurology as part of a residency with the European College of Veterinary Neurology (ECVN) covering all areas of neurology including advanced imaging diagnostics, electrophysiology, neuropathology, and neurosurgery. Clinical neurology is a cross-species discipline, therefore both large and small animals are treated, with dogs and cats being the primary focus. Daily case discussions are conducted, with a weekly journal club and book club. Additionally, conducting a scientific project and giving presentations are integral parts of the training.

#### **Duration and Location:**

A 3 to 4-year program with rotations in radiology, internal medicine, anaesthesia and emergency medicine, pathology, and ophthalmology. Alongside clinical work, tasks include summarizing the scientific project for publication (as first author), writing a case report (as first author) for publication in a peer-reviewed journal, and maintaining a case log to achieve credentials.

Attainment of the title of board-certified Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Neurology (Dipl. ECVN).
